## 2010 Service Area Review Summary

**Child Care Services** - the provision of care for the children of clients who are HIV-positive while the clients attend medical or other appointments or Ryan White Program-related meetings, groups, or training. Provision of care for children of clients who are HIV positive while clients are attending medical or other care related appointments including mental health, dental care and case management. Does not include day care while the client is at work.

There are currently 4 contracts with metro providers and 1 contracts with greater MN providers to serve 37 and 6 clients respectively.

### DATA SUMMARY HIGHLIGHTS

In the 2010 Comprehensive Needs Assessment of Minnesotans Living with HIV Disease, 94% of the 326 respondents indicated that they had not received child care while attending medical or other appointments or Ryan White Program-related meetings, groups or training within the past year. Of those who had not received child care while attending medical or other appointments or Ryan White Program-related meetings, groups or training in the past year (n=307), only six people (2%) indicated that they needed to receive child care while attending medical or other appointments or Ryan White Program-related meetings, groups or training. The barriers or reasons listed by those six people who needed to but were unable to receive child care while attending medical or other appointments or Ryan White Program-related meetings, groups or training during the past year included did not know where to go for information (2), inability to pay (1), and personal issues (1).

Prior to 2008, utilization data for this service area was derived from Emergency Financial Assistance expenditure reports because Child Care Services was delivered through Emergency Financial Assistance.
