2010 Service Area Review Summary

Home & Community Based Health Services - includes skilled health services furnished to the individual in the individual's home based on a written plan of care established by a case management team that includes appropriate health care professionals. Includes durable medical equipment; home health aide services and personal care services in the home; day treatment or other partial hospitalization services; home intravenous/aerosolized drug therapy (including prescription drugs administered as part of such therapy); routine diagnostics testing administered in the home; and appropriate developmental, mental health, and rehab. Inpatient hospitals services, nursing home and other long term care facilities are NOT included.

There is currently 1 contract with a metro provider and 0 contracts with greater MN providers to serve 24 clients.

DATA SUMMARY HIGHLIGHTS

In the 2010 Comprehensive Needs Assessment of Minnesotans Living with HIV Disease, 14% of the 326 respondents indicated that they had received home or community-based health care services within the 12 months. Of those who had not received this service in the past twelve months (n=280), only nine people (16%) indicated that they needed the service. The barriers or reasons listed by those nine people who needed to but were unable to access the service during the past year included system barriers (e.g. difficult to access, case manager resistant), no coverage, and difficulty in qualifying for service.

A new provider was selected in 2007. The current provider has worked with the grantee to make services more accessible and determine how best to meet the needs of consumers needing this service and determining how to best meet the existing need with limited resources.
