**HIV tests conducted in Minnesota using local, state & federal funds as of 12/31/10**

The total annual number of HIV tests conducted in Minnesota using local, state and federal funds as of 12/31/10 was 45,601, of which 12,724 tests were funded through the MDH’s CDC Counseling Testing and Referral grant for Minnesota and 32,697 were funded by a Minnesota Health Care Program (including Medicaid) with a combination of federal (48%) and state (52%) funds. Data on the number of individuals informed of their status is not available for tests funded by a Minnesota Health Care Program since the only source of data is based on submitted claims for HIV antibody tests. An additional 180 tests were provided by the Minneapolis Department of Health’s School-Based Clinics. The following data is only for those tests funded by the CDC CTR grant and School-Based Clinics.
